

My experience in acute care vs home health

- Psychosocial barriers




Homebound



- COVID-19 allowed all of us to experience the feeling of being homebound
- Fortunately, most of us could return to our normal activities
- To be eligible for home health, a physician must determine that the patient is
 <u>homebound</u>, meaning there is a normal inability to leave the home and leaving home requires a significant and taxing effort
- Our patients are typically the very old, chronically ill, and frail


Access to Care: Alabama's #2 Community Health Indicator

- Alabamians identified "access to care" as the 2nd highest health concern in Alabama
- Addressing access to health care services improves prevention of disease and reduces disability due to disease
- Rural individuals could carry a higher health risk for not having robust access to care
- Alabama's geography is considered 96% rural



Enhabit in Oneonta, Alabama

- Oneonta, AL population 6,938
- The county seat of Blount County
- We cover Blount, rural Jefferson and Etowah counties
- We cared for 635 patients in 2023
- We made more than 14,000 visits in 2023
- We drove more than 229,000 miles to provide care
- 14 full-time employees and 10 part-time employees



Patient Impact from home health clinicians

Operational Concerns and Challenges

- Staff shortages (aging workforce, not enough graduates, burnout)
- Increasing acuity and complexity of patient needs
- Rapid growth of Medicare advantage plans and member enrollment
- Inflationary pressures (fuel and transportation, supplies, payroll, etc.)
- Home health cuts reduce my ability to compete for high quality clinicians
- Home health cuts reduce my ability to innovate and invest in care at home
- Home health cuts limit my ability to retain and recruit staff
