
Home Health Access Worsens

More than a third of Medicare patients directed to home health after a hospitalization – did not access Home Health.

The Percentage of Patients Not accessing Home Health Increased by 2.3% from 2022 - 2023



Patients not accessing Home Health after hospital discharge had a 41% higher mortality rate than those who gained access to Home Health.

Mortality rates remained high across 2022-2023.



Access to Home Health results in 34% lower readmission rates.

For patients directed to Home Health after discharge, those receiving home health within 7 days of discharge saw substantially lower hospital readmission *rates* compared to those who went home without services.



Gaining access to Home Health after discharge lowers Medicare spending.

Patients who had access to Home Health spent less overall than patients who were directed to home health and didn't receive it – representing a 5.5% savings in 2023 to the Medicare Trust Fund.


